

Contract of use for Plumpton College Landrover and livestock trailer



Driver Checklist

1. Members must book the Landrover & or Trailer at least 5 working days in advance of use.
2. Members must bring a valid driving licence and a copy of their fully comprehensive vehicle insurance when collecting the Landrover and trailer.

Conditions of Use

- Diesel costs will be covered by Plumpton College who will charge 60p/mile to (listed & agreed) members of the Weald Grazing & Netherfield Centre Network.
- There is no charge for use of the trailer to WGN/ Netherfield Centre Network & it can be used in combination with the Landrover or alone.
- It is the responsibility of the user to accurately read and record the starting mileage reading and the end reading or the charge will be levied at a daily rate of £200.
- Payments of all outstanding accounts must be paid within 10 working days of the date of the invoice.
- To hire this vehicle you must have fully comprehensive insurance and be over 25 years old.
- It is the responsibility of the hirer to return the Landrover and/or livestock trailer to Ivyland Farm, Netherfield in a clean and undamaged condition.
- Unless agreed in advance the Landrover must be returned to Ivyland Farm by 6pm each evening. It will be available for use from 8am each morning. If kept elsewhere it is the responsibility of the person(s) using the Landrover to ensure it is safely parked and locked up.
- If damage to either the vehicle or the trailer occurs it must be reported to Plumpton College who reserve the right to charge the hirer for any repairs necessary.
- After moving livestock and unloading the animals the vehicle and trailer must be fully cleansed and disinfected as soon as possible, before the vehicle and/or trailer is used again and in any case within 24 hours after final unloading. Wheels, wheel arches and mud flaps must also be cleansed and disinfected.
